CLUB BEGININGS

After an attempt in 1958 to form a club for migrants of Altavilla Irpina that lasted less than a year the Altavilla Club was established in February 1974 as an unincorporated body known as Circolo Sportivo Altavillesi and was then incorporated as Circolo Sportivo Altavilla Irpina on 22nd September 1975. The club's name was officially changed to Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club Inc on 16th February 1992 and remains the same today.

The club originated through the love of sports, especially soccer and the will of the Altavillese community to start a sports and social environment which they had left behind in Altavilla Irpina, Italy.

Through playing soccer at the Kensington Gardens Reserve, various BBQs held at Luigi Di Troia's home and other venues the concept of creating a sports and social club grew. A preliminary meeting was then held to advance the strategy of creating a new sport and/or social club.

On 19th May 1974 the first annual general meeting of the club was held at the Hackney Tramway Hall. Members elected included Pasquale Rossi as President and Treasurer, Benny Iasiello - Secretary and committee members – Antonio Villani, Antonio Picariello, Pellegrino Picariello and Luigi Di Troia. The purpose of the meeting was to implement sports and social committees and a

new club constitution. The initial constitution stated that the club did not have any political or religious affiliations.

Given President Pasquale Rossi's experience with the SA Amateur Soccer League, the club's constitution was based around similar objectives as well as Altavillese cultural traditions. An important point was for persons who wanted to join the club's membership, he or she needed to be of Altavillese descent or married to an Altavillese born in Italy.

The first social function was a Dinner Dance held at the Hackney Hall in early June 1974 with everybody bringing a basket supper.

There was a Dinner Dance for New Year's Eve in 1974 at the Hackney Hall which over 400 people attended. Functions were also held at St Clair Woodville which 1,000 people attended. Functions were also held at St Bernard's Recreation Centre Campbelltown.

The first soccer team played in the Industrial League against teams from various factories. The team was called Metropolitan and wore red shirts.

In 1975 the club applied to play in the South Australian Amateur League and being a new club was admitted to the lowest division which was Division 10. The team's name was changed to Adelaide Villa. Adelaide Villa won promotion through the divisions to eventually reached Division 1 and then went into the Saturday League.

One of Adelaide Villa's success story was Charley Villani. From the junior team Charley Villani went on to play with

Adelaide City in the National Soccer League between 1984 and 1989 and played for the Australian Socceroos in 1987. Charley's father, Antonio was also the first appointed coach for Adelaide Villa. He coached for many years and was very well respected.

CLUB PREMISES

On an operational basis the club purchased an old Victorian House at 281 The Parade Beulah Park on 12th July 1977. It was a large house and was renovated the first time to include meeting rooms, a kitchen, a hall, ladies and men's toilets, bar, and large cellar. Given the large block it was on there was ample parking for some members. Most of the renovations were completed by skilled club members for free. A Bocce court in later years was added and regularly used on Fridays, Wednesdays, and Sundays. In the early years the ladies on the social committee, with the help of their husbands, used to manually make fusilli pasta for various functions for many years.

Functions were mainly held on Saturday and Sunday nights to help pay the purchase of the club. As part of the revenue raising activities Founder Members paid a founder member loan payment of \$250.00 to assist with the club's mortgage. The payment was on an interest free loan basis. Most members ended up donating the money with no conditions attached. Other revenue raising activities included staging dinner dances offsite

to celebrate Father's Day, Mother's Day, and New Years Eve Dances. On 14 January 1985 the property at 279 The Parade Beulah Park was added to the club's property portfolio. It was purchased earlier by two club committee members and later transferred to the club based on what the members paid for it.

During the years from 1977 until the early 1980's significant renovations were undertaken to both properties. The properties were eventually amalgamated under one title.

There were no restrictions to becoming a member of the club apart from office bearers, of which, three fifths of the committee had to be of Altavillese decent.

The club was opened on Wednesday, Friday nights and Sunday mornings and used mainly by men to play cards. On Sunday evenings the club was opened, and families attended for a meal which was mainly pasta and was cooked in the original kitchen of the house although new ovens and stove had been installed.

Over the years the club organised many country bus trips which were frequented by club members and were very well enjoyed. The club's women social committee were very proud of supporting club functions with their fine cooking and social interactions.

There were several significant events held at the club over the years especially with Adelaide Villa soccer annual player presentations. The club was also able to make sizable donations to the Parrocchia Santa Maria



Assunta Altavilla Irpina and the 2016 Italian Earthquake appeal through holding dinner dances. In 2021 the club made a significant donation to St Francis Xavier's Cathedral with the purchase of a bronze statue dedicated to Australia's first Saint, Mary MacKillop – St Mary of the Cross.

During 1984 Greg Crafter was sought after by the President of the Altavilla Club, Renato Coscia to assist with a grant submission under the Commonwealth Community Employment Program through the Burnside City Council. After much consultation with Altavilla Irpina Sports & Social Club Committee members the grant submission to the State Government was successful. The Community Employment grant enabled the demolition of the house and construction of new clubrooms at 281 the Parade Norwood.

THE CLUB, ST PELLEGRINO MARTIRE AND COMMITTEE AMALGAMATIONS

In 1978 a separate independent incorporated body was established which was called the St Pellegrino Martire Committee Inc. The members from the organization were all from Altavilla Irpina. The First mass in honour of San Pellegrino was celebrated in Latin by Father Ambrose Byrne on 25th August 1977 the same day the mass is celebrated in Altavilla Irpina and the first major festa was staged at St Ignatius Church in Norwood on the 28th and 29th of January 1978.

The Altavilla Sports and Social Club who always maintained a special devotion to St Pellegrino Martire were able to support their festas constantly for over 25 years. They were, however, independent bodies. The festas were hugely popular and very well attended. The Altavilla Sports and Social Club assisted in running various activities throughout the many years of operations.

As a result of the club's constitution being changed to allow the club to be involved in religious activities it was agreed upon in 2015 that due to the age constraints of the St Pellegrino Martire committee members and illnesses, it was decided to consolidate and amalgamate the St Pellegrino Martire Committee, the San Pellegrino Battenti Committee with Altavilla Irpina Sports, and Social Club.

The amalgamation discussions were initiated by the Altavilla Sports and Social Club President Peter Varricchio and Greg Crafter facilitated discussions between the committees of all three associations to achieve the amalgamation.

As a result of the amalgamation of the three associations the Festa was able to recommence at the Annunciation Church Hectorville in January 2016 fifteen years after the last complete one at St Ignatius Church and College Norwood.

THE CLUB TODAY

Over 50 years the club has been through highs and lows, but the Altavillese traditions have been maintained and endured. Through the commitment and dedication of the past and present President(s) the Altavilla Sports and Social Club has continued to thrive. President Dominic Reppucci now currently leads the Management Committee. The members of the St Pellegrino Martire Committee and all our volunteers the club have received the highest of praise from members and the public. In addition, the St Pellegrino Festas have increased in popularity, and become the premier Festa in Adelaide and the club has kept the faith.

LE ORIGINI DEL CLUB

Dopo un tentativo durato meno di un anno, nel 1958, di creare un club per migranti provenienti da Altavilla Irpina, nel febbraio 1974, venne fondato l'Altavilla Club, un ente privo di personalità giuridica, chiamato Circolo Sportivo Altavillesi, che divenne poi una società costituita, chiamata Circolo Sportivo Altavilla Irpina, il 22 settembre 1975. Il nome della società venne ufficialmente cambiato in Altavilla Irpina Sports and Social Club Inc il 16 febbraio 1992 e si chiama ancora oggi così.

Il club nasce dall'amore per lo sport, in particolare per il calcio, e dalla volontà della comunità altavillese di dare vita ad un ambiente sportivo e sociale, simile a quello che avevano lasciato ad Altavilla Irpina, in Italia.

Giocando a calcio a Kensington Gardens Reserve, organizzando vari barbecue a casa di Luigi Di Troia e in altri posti, è maturata l'idea di creare un club sportivo e sociale. Si è poi tenuto un incontro preliminare per portare avanti la strategia di creazione di un nuovo club sportivo e/o sociale.

Il 19 maggio 1974 si tenne la prima assemblea generale annuale del club presso l'Hackney Tramway Hall. Tra i membri eletti c'erano Pasquale Rossi come Presidente e Tesoriere, Benny Iasiello - Segretario e membri del comitato - Antonio Villani, Antonio Picariello, Pellegrino Picariello e Luigi Di Troia. Lo scopo dell'incontro era quello di stabilire i comitati sportivi e sociali e una nuova costituzione per il club. La costituzione iniziale affermava che il club non aveva alcuna affiliazione politica o religiosa.

Vista l'esperienza del Presidente Pasquale Rossi con la

Lega Calcio Dilettanti del Sud Australia, la costituzione del club si basava su obiettivi simili e sulle tradizioni culturali altavillesi. Un punto importante era che le persone che volevano aderire al club, dovevano essere di origine altavillese o sposate con un altavillese nato in Italia.

La prima funzione fu una cena danzante tenutasi a Hackney Hall all'inizio di giugno 1974, dove tutti portarono qualcosa per la cena.

Nel 1974, ci fu una cena danzante per la vigilia di Capodanno a Hackney Hall, alla quale parteciparono oltre 400 persone. Si sono svolte funzioni anche a St Clair Woodville a cui hanno partecipato 1.000 persone. Le funzioni si sono svolte anche presso il St Bernard's Recreation Centre di Campbelltown.

La prima squadra di calcio giocava nella Lega Industriale contro squadre di varie fabbriche. La squadra si chiamava Metropolitan e indossava magliette rosse.

Nel 1975, il club fece domanda per giocare nella Lega Calcio Dilettanti del Sud Australia ed essendo un nuovo club fu ammesso alla divisione più bassa che era la Divisione 10. Il nome della squadra fu cambiato in Adelaide Villa. Adelaide Villa ha vinto la promozione attraverso le divisioni per raggiungere infine la Prima Divisione e entrare poi nella Saturday League.

Una delle storie di successo dell'Adelaide Villa è stata Charley Villani. Dalla squadra junior Charley Villani ha continuato a giocare con l'Adelaide City nella National Soccer League tra il 1984 e il 1989 e ha giocato per gli Australian Socceroos nel 1987. Il padre di Charley, Antonio, è stato anche il primo allenatore dell'Adelaide Villa. Ha allenato per molti anni ed era molto rispettato.



LOCALI DEL CLUB

Su base operativa, il club acquistò una vecchia casa vittoriana al numero 281, The Parade, Beulah Park, il 12 luglio 1977. Era una grande casa e fu ristrutturata la prima volta per includere sale riunioni, una cucina, un corridoio, bagni per uomini e donne, bar e un'ampia cantina. Dato il grande isolato su cui si trovava, c'era un ampio parcheggio per i membri del club. La maggior parte dei lavori di ristrutturazione sono stati completati gratuitamente da membri qualificati del club. Negli anni successivi, venne aggiunto un campo da bocce, utilizzato regolarmente il venerdì, il mercoledì e la domenica. Nei primi anni, le signore del comitato sociale, con l'aiuto dei mariti, hanno fatto i fusilli a mano per varie funzioni.

Le funzioni si tenevano principalmente il sabato e la domenica sera per contribuire a pagare l'acquisto del club. Nell'ambito delle attività di raccolta fondi, i membri fondatori hanno pagato un prestito per i membri fondatori di \$ 250,00 per assistere con il mutuo del club. Il pagamento avveniva sulla base di un prestito senza interessi. La maggior parte dei membri ha finito per donare il denaro senza alcuna condizione. Altre attività di raccolta fondi includevano l'organizzazione di cene danzanti fuori sede per celebrare la festa del papà, la festa della mamma e i balli di Capodanno. Il 14 gennaio 1985, la proprietà al numero 279, The Parade, Beulah Park fu aggiunta al portafoglio immobiliare del club. Era stato acquistato in precedenza da due membri del comitato del club e successivamente trasferito al club in base a quanto pagato dai membri.

Nel corso degli anni, dal 1977 fino all'inizio degli anni Ottanta, furono intrapresi importanti lavori di

ristrutturazione in entrambe le proprietà. Le proprietà furono infine accorpate sotto un unico titolo.

Non c'erano restrizioni per diventare membri del club, c'erano restrizioni solo per i titolari di cariche, dato che tre quinti del comitato dovevano essere di origine altavillesi.

Il club era aperto il mercoledì, il venerdì sera e la domenica mattina ed era utilizzato principalmente dagli uomini per giocare a carte. La domenica sera il circolo veniva aperto e le famiglie si riunivano per un pasto preparato nella cucina originale della casa, nonostante fossero stati installati nuovi forni e fornelli.

Nel corso degli anni, il club ha organizzato numerose gite in autobus nella campagna, frequentate dai soci del club e molto apprezzate. Il comitato sociale femminile del club era molto orgoglioso di sostenere le funzioni del club con la sua cucina raffinata e le interazioni sociali.

Ci sono stati diversi eventi significativi tenuti nel club nel corso degli anni, in particolare con le presentazioni annuali dei giocatori dell'Adelaide Villa. Il club ha anche fatto donazioni considerevoli alla Parrocchia Santa Maria Assunta Altavilla Irpina e per il terremoto del 2016 in Italia, organizzando cene danzanti. Nel 2021, il club ha fatto un'importante donazione alla Cattedrale di San Francesco Saverio con l'acquisto di una statua in bronzo dedicata alla prima santa australiana, Mary MacKillop - Santa Maria della Croce.

Nel 1984, Greg Crafter fu contattato dal presidente dell'Altavilla Club, Renato Coscia, per assistere nella richiesta di sovvenzioni nell'ambito del Commonwealth Community Employment Program, attraverso il Consiglio comunale di Burnside. Dopo lunghe consultazioni con i membri del Comitato dell'Altavilla Irpina Sports &

Social Club, la richiesta di sovvenzioni al governo statale è stata approvata. Le sovvenzioni per l'occupazione comunitaria hanno consentito la demolizione della casa e la costruzione di nuove sale del club al numero 281, The Parade, Norwood.

IL CLUB, SAN PELLEGRINO MARTIRE E ACCORPAMENTO DEI COMITATI

In 1978 a separate independent incorporated body was established which Nel 1978, fu costituito un organismo autonomo, denominato Comitato San Pellegrino Martire Inc. I membri dell'organizzazione erano tutti di Altavilla Irpina. La prima messa in onore di San Pellegrino fu celebrata in latino da padre Ambrose Byrne, il 25 agosto 1977, lo stesso giorno in cui si celebra la messa ad Altavilla Irpina e la prima grande festa fu organizzata presso la chiesa di Sant'Ignazio a Norwood il 28 e il 29 gennaio 1978.

L'Altavilla Sports and Social Club, che ha sempre avuto una speciale devozione per San Pellegrino Martire, è riuscito a finanziare le proprie feste per oltre 25 anni. Si trattava, tuttavia, di organismi indipendenti. Le feste erano estremamente popolari e attiravano molte persone. L'Altavilla Sports and Social Club ha contribuito allo svolgimento di diverse attività nel corso dei molti anni di attività.

A seguito della modifica della costituzione del club per consentire al club di essere coinvolto in attività religiose, nel 2015 si è deciso che, a causa dei limiti di età dei membri del comitato San Pellegrino Martire e di questioni

di salute, fosse necessario accorpate il Comitato di San Pellegrino Martire e il Comitato dei Battenti di San Pellegrino con l'Altavilla Irpina Sports, and Social Club.

Le discussioni sulla fusione sono state avviate dal presidente dell'Altavilla Sports and Social Club Peter Varricchio e Greg Crafter ha facilitato le discussioni tra i comitati di tutte e tre le associazioni per raggiungere la fusione.

A seguito della fusione delle tre associazioni, la Festa ha potuto ricominciare presso la Chiesa dell'Annunciazione a Hectorville nel gennaio 2016, quindici anni dopo l'ultima festa completa presso la Chiesa di Sant'Ignazio e Colledge Norwood.

IL CLUB OGGI

In 50 anni, il club ha attraversato alti e bassi, ma le tradizioni altavillesi sono state mantenute. Attraverso l'impegno e la dedizione dei Presidenti passati e presenti, il Club Sportivo e Sociale Altavilla ha continuato a prosperare. Il presidente Dominic Reppucci è attualmente a capo del comitato di gestione. I membri del Comitato San Pellegrino Martire e tutti i nostri volontari del club hanno ricevuto i più alti elogi da parte dei soci e del pubblico. Inoltre, le Feste di San Pellegrino sono diventate sempre più popolari e tra le feste più importanti di Adelaide, e il club ha mantenuto la fede.
